**Ecclesiastes 7:1-8 (NKJV)**

- 1 A good name is better than precious ointment, And the day of death than the day of one's birth;
- 2 Better to go to the house of mourning Than to go to the house of feasting, For that is the end of all men; And the living will take it to heart.
- 3 Sorrow is better than laughter, For by a sad countenance the heart is made better.
- 4 The heart of the wise is in the house of mourning, But the heart of fools is in the house of mirth.
- 5 It is better to hear the rebuke of the wise Than for a man to hear the song of fools.
- 6 For like the crackling of thorns under a pot, So is the laughter of the fool. This also is vanity.
- 7 Surely oppression destroys a wise man's reason, And a bribe debases the heart.
- 8 The end of a thing is better than its beginning; The patient in spirit is better than the proud in spirit.

## Finding What We Need Under the Sun - Finding a Better Perspective

“The words of the Preacher, the son of David, king of Jerusalem” (Ecclesiastes 1:1). The textual evidence points strongly to the writer being Solomon. If this is the case, he was blessed with tremendous knowledge and wisdom from God. The Lord God told Solomon, “behold, I have given you a wise and understanding heart, so that there has not been anyone like you before you, nor shall any like you arise after you” (I Kings 3:12). I believe the great Teacher or Preacher is Solomon. His wisdom is poured out into this book called “Ecclesiastes”.

In the seventh chapter, we receive some practical advice from the Teacher. He gives us a “better perspective” with life under the sun. We are so blessed to have the words of God and the wisdom of such great writers. What he said in this chapter is something we need in the Christian age. We need to see the value of the name we bear in Christ. We need to know it is better to live a long fruitful life. It is better to have the patience to see things all the way through rather than leaving or quitting abruptly. It is better not to live in the past because we neglect the wisdom of the present. Are we wise enough to listen to this great wise Teacher?

Another great Teacher came much later; in fact, He was the greatest Teacher and Savior the world will ever know. King Jesus came so that we can live a much “better life” in Him (John 10:10). How foolish to turn down this better offer than anything that the world could offer! The Teacher of Ecclesiastes breaks to give us a better perspective as we toil and labor under the sun. We need to be reminded constantly about the eternal things that we can hold on to regardless of the state of our world or country.

May we all strive to live each day with this “better perspective” in mind.



Here is what you can do.


1. **Pray for our Elders, Deacons, & Members that we can continue to do the Lord's work, spread the Gospel, and meet the needs of our congregation.**
