Finding What We Need Under the Sun - Finding Help

We all need help. I don't say that lightly or ignorantly. I had a Bible professor who said something that stuck with me. He said, "Preachers need preachers; doctors need doctors; leaders need leaders; coaches need coaches". In other words, we all need help from others regardless of our profession or placement in life. What the Teacher prescribed in his day is no different from what we need. James stated, "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, Who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him" (James 1:5). The help we need in this life is from God. We need wisdom to help guide us in matters of life.
