2 All things come alike to all: One event happens to the righteous and the wicked; To the good, the clean, and the unclean; To him who sacrifices and him who does not sacrifice. ## Finding What We Need Under the Son - Finding Rest

What comes to mind when you hear the word “rest”? Do you think of not getting rest because so much is happening? Do you think of time off from work or vacation time? Do you think of a good night’s sleep? It seems the practice of resting is difficult under the sun.

What about after this life? What about hearing at a funeral the words, “*For the living know that they will die, but the dead know nothing, and they have no more reward for the memory of them is forgotten*”? (Ecclesiastes 9:5) Would this bring great comfort to you? Do you find rest with such words? I don’t, and neither did the Teacher. He saw death as evil and hopeless because the opportunities of life are gone. He said, “*For a living dog is better than a dead lion*”. (Ecclesiastes 9:4) The subject of Ecclesiastes chapter 9 is “death”. It is a strong fact of this life and something we need to understand. We don’t have to live fearing it or being paralyzed in life because of it.

“*There remains therefore a rest for the people of God.*” (Hebrews 4:9) We can look at death much differently because of Jesus Christ. He came and took away the sting of death by His death and resurrection. Death is not the end but a door to complete and ultimate rest for the people of God. Life under the Son of God is restful when crossing the valley of death. May we find the rest we need in our life under the Son.
