Finding What We Need Under the Sun - Living With Great Effort

Do you find yourself lacking a little effort due to the pandemic? I read an article from National Geographic entitled “Are You Procrastinating More? Blame the Pandemic”. 


This training session will cover basic information as well as the new aspects since we upgraded our camera.
