Finding What We Need Under the Sun - Living a Meaningful Life

Have you been pleased with your time spent recently? Last year? Last decade? Overall in life? I believe a “big” question in life has to do with meaning. What is the meaning of my life? If we can answer that, we can live with great purpose.

The Teacher knew this well. He mentions “meaningless” or “vanity” over 30 times in Ecclesiastes. He begins with the words “*Meaningless! Meaningless!*” Says the Teacher. “*Utterly meaningless! Everything is meaningless.*” (1:2 NIV) He concludes with the same words. The answer doesn't change no matter where you are in life. All of physical life is meaningless because it ends. We are reminded of this on a daily basis with obituaries and the news.

What is the answer to this “big” question? What did the wise Teacher discover? He sums it all up in two main answers. It is so simple, and it doesn't require a degree in theology. “*Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God and keep his commandments, For this is man's all.*” (Ecclesiastes 12:13 NKJV) Why do these two truths make up the conclusion and answer the meaning of life? They apply to every person. First of all, the rich need to hear this with the poor. The old need to hear this with the young. Who on earth doesn't need to “fear God” or “keep His commandments”? Secondly, we will all be judged by God. Every work and every secret thing will be brought before the judgement seat of God. This is why it is important to know the meaning of life. We need to think about the future and prepare for it. Thank you, Jesus, for helping us all with what we need in this life and the life to come. To God be the glory!

Wednesday Night Bible Study Resumes - April 7th (6:30-7:30)

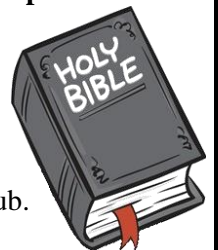
Join us as our Wednesday Night Bible Study resumes on April 7th!

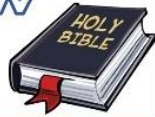
