The Sword

Mark 14:43-50 (NKJV)

43 And immediately, while He was still speaking, Judas, one of the twelve, with a great multitude with swords and clubs, came from the chief priests and the scribes and the elders. 44 Now His betrayer had given them a signal, saying, "Whomever I kiss, He is the One; seize Him and lead Him away safely." 45 As soon as he had come, immediately he went up to Him and said to Him, "Rabbi, Rabbi!" and kissed Him. 46 Then they laid their hands on Him and took Him. 47 And one of those who stood by drew his sword and struck the servant of the high priest, and cut off his ear. 48 Then Jesus answered and said to them, "Have you come out, as against a robber, with swords and clubs to take Me? 49 I was daily with you in the temple teaching, and you did not seize Me. But the Scriptures must be fulfilled." 50 Then they all forsook Him and fled.

Remember These Things: Introduction To The Sword

The apostle Peter informed the Christians in the first century “to remember these things” (II Peter 1:15 NIV). What things? He was referring to the things regarding the coming of Jesus Christ in power and the things regarding the honor and glory Christ had received while in the flesh. Peter knew a lot about the things of Christ because he was there. He was an eyewitness to the miracles, teachings, and disappointments.

The “sword” represents the world’s approach to conquering through power, grit, and might. The sword of the world is taking things by military might and political power. Swords and clubs were brought against Jesus while He was in the Garden of Gethsemane. Why did they approach Jesus with such weaponry and force? Did Judas and Peter not understand that He was to die and be raised on the third day? Did they miss the point that the “kingdom of God” is unlike all other kingdoms? Jesus didn’t put up a fight to overpower the opposing force. He willingly gave Himself up into their custody. When they laid their hands on Jesus, Peter drew his sword and cut off the high priest’s servant’s ear. Remember, Peter was a fisherman by trade and not a soldier. I believe he was aiming for the head and missed, just enough to cut off the ear. Peter and Judas were privileged to sit at their Rabbi’s feet and hear about the “kingdom of God”. Jesus spoke about it frequently throughout the three years. However, they demonstrated with swords and clubs that they thought the kingdom was of this world.

Every new kingdom in history used money, politics, and/or swords to come into power. This is not the case with God and His kingdom. The kingdom of God is without swords and clubs. It is a kingdom of suffering, weakness, poverty, and rejection.

It continues to stand at odds with anything worldly. The kingdom of God is to love your neighbor as yourself. The kingdom of God calls us to be peacemakers, not troublemakers. The kingdom of God is denying yourself, taking up your cross daily, and following Jesus. The sword is not how things get done and accomplished in the kingdom. It is through the surrender of our will to the will of God. Peter learned, and Judas learned, this in two different ways. One got back up, and the other one didn’t.

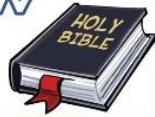
