Remember These Things:

The Darkness

By Josh Barnett

Mark 15:33-39 (NKJV)

33 Now when the sixth hour had come, there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour. 34 And at the ninth hour Jesus cried out with a loud voice, saying, "Eloi, Eloi, lama sabachthani?" which is translated, "My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me?"

35 Some of those who stood by, when they heard that, said, "Look, He is calling for Elijah!" 36 Then someone ran and filled a sponge full of sour wine, put it on a reed, and offered it to Him to drink, saying, "Let Him alone; let us see if Elijah will come to take Him down."

37 And Jesus cried out with a loud voice, and breathed His last.

38 Then the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom. 39 So when the centurion, who stood opposite Him, saw that He cried out like this and breathed His last, he said, "Truly this Man was the Son of God!"

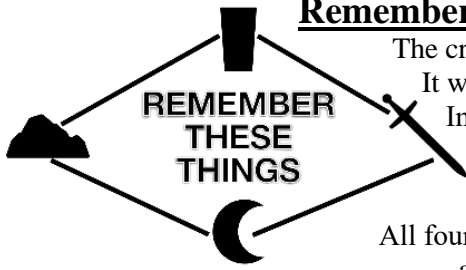

Remember These Things: Introduction To The Darkness

The crucifixion was designed to be the most humiliating and gruesome method of execution. It was a bloody spectacle for the worst offenders which ended in shock or asphyxiation. Imagine what Jesus' followers felt as they watched this scene around the cross. They had seen Jesus calm storms, banish sickness, and cure the worst demon possessed. He was the Christ. How could this be happening?

All four Gospel writers inform us that Jesus' death happened in the dark. What time was Jesus arrested in the garden? It was dark. When was Jesus' trial before the Sanhedrin? It happened in the dark. His betrayal, arrest, secretive parts of His trial, and His death were in the dark. "Now when the sixth hour had come, there was darkness over the whole land until the ninth hour" (Mark 15:33). This would be Noon to 3:00 P.M. in our time. Jesus' last hours were in the dark. This darkness was not a solar eclipse because it can't happen during the time of a full moon with the Passover. This was a supernatural darkness.

In the Bible, darkness during day is a sign of God's displeasure and judgement. Consider the darkness over Egypt at the time of the first Passover (Exodus 10:21-23). When the darkness fell, God acted in divine judgment on Egypt. Who was God judging when darkness fell on Jesus? The divine judgement was on Jesus. He took upon Himself the burden of the darkness physically, emotionally, and spiritually. Darkness helps us to remember the things Jesus did for us. He faced the greatest darkness by offering Himself for our sake.

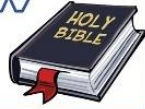

All of these questions will be answered this week!

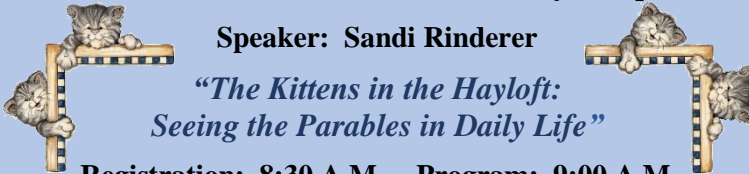

Herald of Truth Ministries

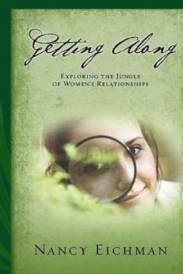
