Remember These Things:

The Stone

By Josh Barnett

Mark 16:1-8 (NKJV)

1 Now when the Sabbath was past, Mary Magdalene, Mary the mother of James, and Salome bought spices, that they might come and anoint Him. 2 Very early in the morning, on the first day of the week, they came to the tomb when the sun had risen. 3 And they said among themselves, "Who will roll away the stone from the door of the tomb for us?" 4 But when they looked up, they saw that the stone had been rolled away—for it was very large. 5 And entering the tomb, they saw a young man clothed in a long white robe sitting on the right side; and they were alarmed. 6 But he said to them, "Do not be alarmed. You seek Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He is risen! He is not here. See the place where they laid Him. 7 But go, tell His disciples—and Peter—that He is going before you into Galilee; there you will see Him, as He said to you." 8 So they went out quickly and fled from the tomb, for they trembled and were amazed. And they said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid.

Remember These Things: Introduction To The Stone

The Pharisees and chief priests were not satisfied with the death of Jesus. They came to Pilate and said, "Sir, we remember, while He was still alive, how that deceiver said, 'After three days I will rise'" (Matthew 27:63). They wanted insurance from Pilate that the dead body of Jesus wouldn't be stolen by His believers. They believed that if this happened it would be the worst deception. In their minds, this false narrative would persuade their followers. They wanted Pilate's permission to guard the tomb of Jesus. Pilate gave them the authority and the help of a guard to secure the opening of the tomb. "They went and made the tomb secure, sealing the stone and setting the guard" (Matthew 27:66). Who were "they"? They were the chief priests and the Pharisees. They were the constant antagonists of Jesus and His followers. Their answer was to make sure the dead body was in the tomb and that the opening was sealed with a stone. They made sure there was no deception by setting guards to watch out front. Don't you think they celebrated and gloated in thinking they had won that Saturday?

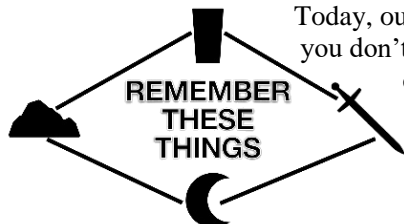
The stone represents the world's response to Jesus and His teachings. The stone was designed to shut out and quiet down the spread of Jesus' teachings and followers. Others throughout history have stepped up to squash the Lord's church and the message of God.

Today, our culture rolls the stone shut to the teachings of Christ. Have you ever heard "there are two things you don't talk about with people: religion and politics"? There are more people "unchurched" than "of the church". I wonder if the pandemic will shut out more people in time from the message because of "getting out of the habit". The stone is a reminder of what happens when power is in our hands.

The empty tomb is a reminder of what happens when the power is of God. He is risen!

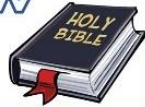

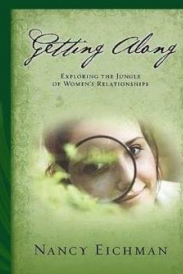
