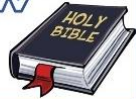

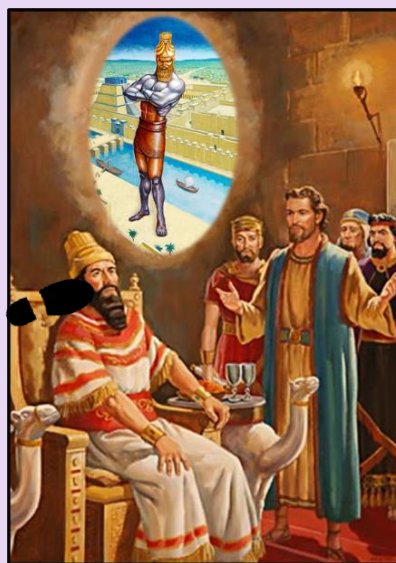

Roger Sauls

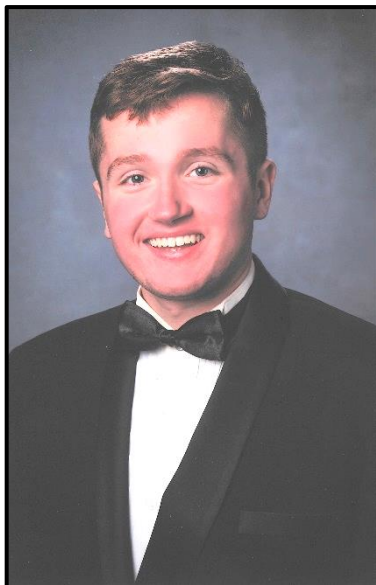
