**A Royal Kingdom:
King Hezekiah Prays**

2 Kings 20:1-6 (NKJV)

1 In those days Hezekiah was sick and near death. And Isaiah the prophet, the son of Amoz, went to him and said to him, "Thus says the Lord: 'Set your house in order, for you shall die, and not live.'"

2 Then he turned his face toward the wall, and prayed to the Lord, saying, 3 "Remember now, O Lord, I pray, how I have walked before You in truth and with a loyal heart, and have done what was good in Your sight." And Hezekiah wept bitterly.

4 And it happened, before Isaiah had gone out into the middle court, that the word of the Lord came to him, saying, 5 "Return and tell Hezekiah the leader of My people, 'Thus says the Lord, the God of David your father: "I have heard your prayer, I have seen your tears; surely I will heal you. On the third day you shall go up to the house of the Lord. 6 And I will add to your days fifteen years. I will deliver you and this city from the hand of the king of Assyria; and I will defend this city for My own sake, and for the sake of My servant David.'"

A Royal Kingdom: King Hezekiah Prays

Do you realize how special you are to God? Peter conveyed our worth and value in one verse.

“But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of the darkness into His marvelous light.” (1 Peter 2:9)

One of the things that makes our relationship with God so special is prayer. Are we known for our prayer lives? Would someone say that we pray often? Do we demonstrate in all things the need to pray to God? I hope we see prayer more than a habitual thing to do before a meal or going to sleep. Prayer is too important to be limited to a few activities of our day.

We must *“pray without ceasing”*. (1 Thessalonians 5:17)

Our next king demonstrated the royal act of praying. Hezekiah was not like his father. He returned to the monotheistic worship of the One true God. He tore down the idols and broke the bronze serpent. Hezekiah was a king who trusted in the Lord and kept His commands. He was told by the prophet Isaiah to set his house in order because he was going to die.

Hezekiah was sick and near death when he heard this from Isaiah. This king went to the One higher than him in prayer. He offered a simple but sincere prayer to God. The Lord answered his prayer by adding 15 more years to his life. How often are we praying?

Let us consider this “Royal Act” of praying from King Hezekiah.

New Heights – Summer Camp Sponsors



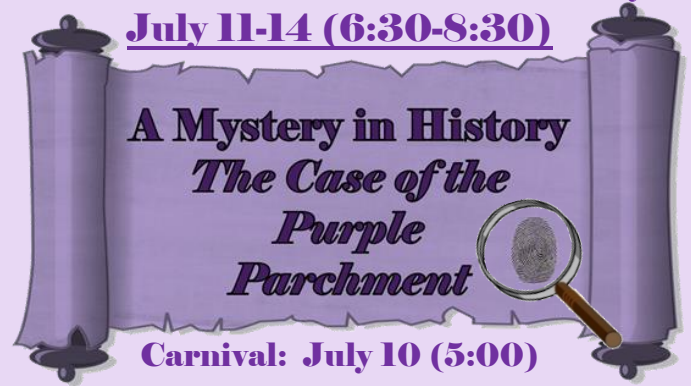
New Heights Christian Community Services is a Mission supported by Charlotte Heights.
