1 Timothy 6:12-16 (NKJV)

A Royal Kingdom: King Jesus Requires Obedience

Do you remember when the disciples awoke Jesus because of the great storm on the Sea of Galilee? They said to Him, “*Lord, save us! We are perishing!*” (Matthew 8:25) We know that four disciples were professional fishermen. I believe they had experienced a storm or two on the sea. However, this was a great tempest that arose on the sea. The storm was so strong that these grown men thought they were perishing. Jesus arose and rebuked the sea, and there was a great calm. The disciples marveled and said, “*Who can this be, that even the winds and the sea obey Him?*” (Matthew 8:27) There was no doubt in their minds at that moment that Jesus was greater. They would eventually see throughout their ministry that Jesus is the “King of kings and Lord of lords”.

Is there any doubt in our minds that Jesus is the King? Other storms have come into our lives that challenge our faith and the way we look at Jesus. We can grow up believing Jesus is the King of kings, but things can happen to us that make us question. We may not be as certain as the disciples were that day when the wind and sea obeyed Him.



The greatest King requires obedience, but we must see Him as He is. It is not a question of “what” but “Who”. Who do the wind and sea obey? It is the King of all kings and the Lord of all lords, Jesus Christ. The final royal act is “obeying”. Let us consider the fourth and final King.

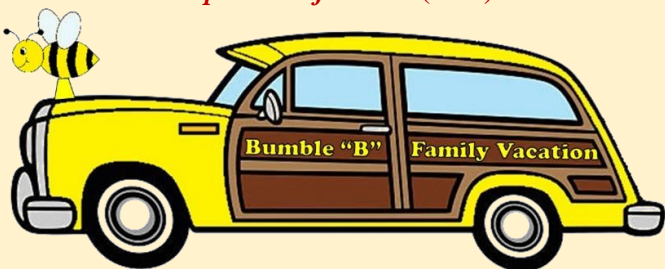
KIDSPIRATION

"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future." (NIV)

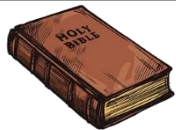

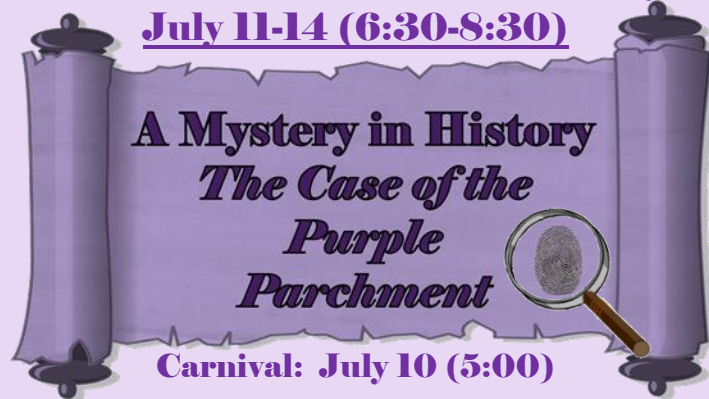
