Be Different

Daniel 1:5-9 (NKJV)

5 And the king appointed for them a daily provision of the king's delicacies and of the wine which he drank, and three years of training for them, so that at the end of that time they might serve before the king. 6 Now from among those of the sons of Judah were Daniel, Hananiah, Mishael, and Azariah. 7 To them the chief of the eunuchs gave names: he gave Daniel the name Belteshazzar; to Hananiah, Shadrach; to Mishael, Meshach; and to Azariah, Abed-Nego. 8 But Daniel purposed in his heart that he would not defile himself with the portion of the king's delicacies, nor with the wine which he drank; therefore he requested of the chief of the eunuchs that he might not defile himself. 9 Now God had brought Daniel into the favor and goodwill of the chief of the eunuchs.

A Message in History: Be Different

What does it mean to be a Christian? I believe it is a higher calling by God to be different. This past week my wife and I stood in a long line to show our support to a family in their tragic loss of a two-year-old daughter. We finally got our turn to talk to the mother and family. She was telling us how thankful she was for the time they had with their daughter and that she is now with Jesus.

What tremendous faith at a difficult time! This is different from the world's response to such grief.

The family reminded us that we are unable to do it without God.

Imagine being captured by a foreign entity and taken into captivity to live in a land that believed and practiced much differently than you. The Babylonians, under the leadership of Nebuchadnezzar, conquered the city of Jerusalem. They looted the temple and enslaved many Jewish people. They carried the articles of the house of

God to the land of Shinar and to the house of their god. (Daniel 1:2) Daniel was one of those in exile.

Daniel's name means "God is my Judge". He chose to be different while in exile. He faced life-threatening tests, but his faith never wavered. He wasn't without hope. He served the same God in Whom we serve today.

He was able to press forward because of God. Can we be so different?

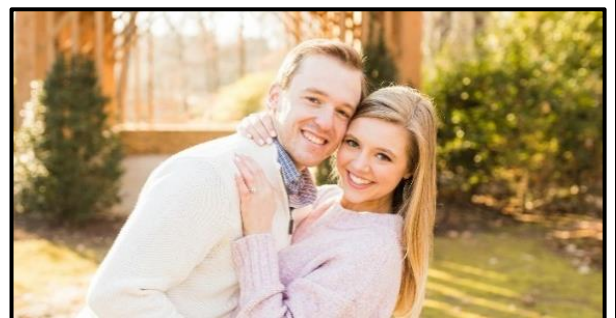

If you plan to eat ANY night, sign up at the VBS Booth.

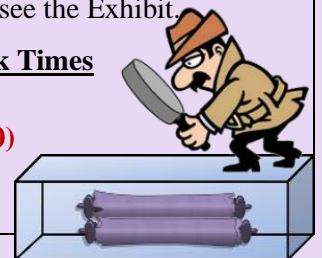
VBS Sunday Morning Kickoff
