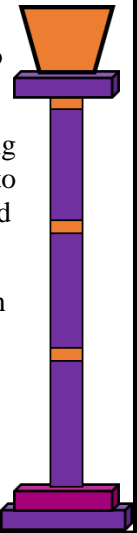
A Message in History: Be Devoted

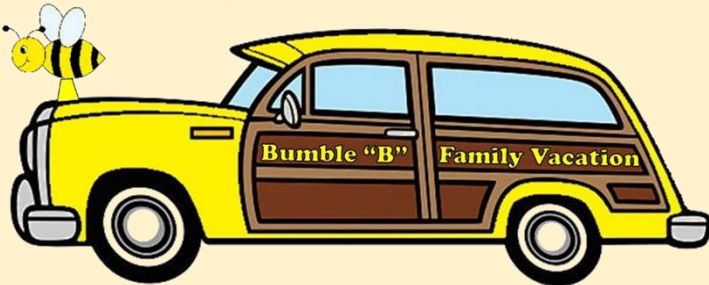
Children's Ministry
