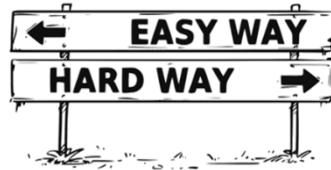

The Hard Way Series: “The Easy Way is the Wrong Way”

Our series in August comes from the words of our Lord in His Sermon on the Mount. *“Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it.”* (Matthew 7:13-14). I don't believe Jesus is trying to scare us, but rather He is being open and honest with us. Like a strong river current, we can easily go down the wide and broad way. It's much easier to go along with culture, the world, and sin. Some try to make the narrow way a little wider by tolerance towards sin and their way of life.

One of the problems that plagues our minds is “Entitlement”. This is the belief that we are excluded from responsibility, and we are owed special treatment. Entitlement is not just the spoiled person refusing to work. It is much more. Entitlement can be the person receiving a poor job evaluation because of their refusal to invest in the job. Classes run 08/23/2021 – 11/18/2021.

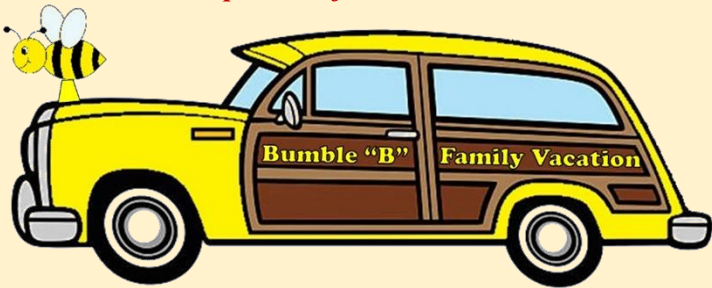
