The Hard Way Series: “Making The Hard Way More Doable”

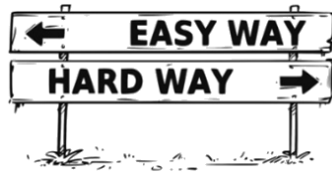
The thirteen states declared on July 4, 1776,

“We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable Rights, that among these are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness”.

Our founding fathers wanted us to have the rights to freely pursue meaningful life. These “unalienable rights” don’t excuse us from personal responsibility.

Have you stopped to listen to what is being said? “I deserve a better grade.” “I deserve a better job with more money.” “I deserve a better person to be with.” We use the phrase “I deserve” as a right to get what we want. It’s too easy to live this way. It’s much easier to say “I deserve” than “I am responsible”.

What is easier is not always what is best for us. “I am responsible” frees us to get where we need to go. *“For the gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life, and those who find it are few.”* (Matthew 7:14, ESV) I want to make the



“hard way” more doable. It starts with our speech and mind. It’s more doable when we change from “I deserve” to “I am responsible”.
