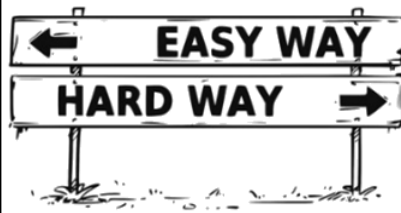
Our Ladies Bible Class will resume on Wednesday, September 8th, at 10:00.

The Hard Way Series: “Making The Hard Way More Doable”

There is nothing pleasant about “depression”. The word even sounds terrible and unpleasant. I must mention that it is my believe that it is a lack of understanding and knowledge to assume someone dealing with depression has a faith issue. It is real, and many Christians struggle with it. If you look carefully, a spiritual truth is buried within the word. If you remove the letters “d”, “e”, and “i”, you have “press on”.

Paul stated, “*I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.*” (Philippians 3:14 NIV) Paul gave us the motivation to continue the “hard way” that leads to life. What could be better than “*heavenward in Christ Jesus*”? We must consider the overall goal rather than the temporary moment. It doesn’t come easily for us to live ahead. We can hear what we need to do but still not do it. We can find ourselves making excuses with our personal responsibilities to God and others.

We have been focused on the problem of “Entitlement” this month and how it plagues every aspect of our lives. I can tell you to “live for heaven”, but you may struggle to live in the moment. How do we get up and press forward? You have to start with no more excuses for yourself. We need the right motivation to live responsibly for God.



The sacrifices you make today are worth it in the end. How do I know? Please don’t take my word on it. Jesus said, “*The gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life and those who enter by it are few.*” (Matthew 7:14, ESV).
