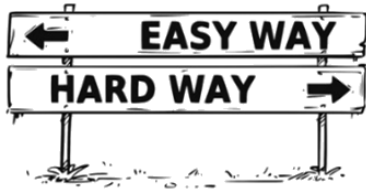
The Hard Way Series: "I Am Accountable"

What's the one thing you would change to improve the effectiveness of Charlotte Heights Church of Christ?
Is your answer about others or yourself? A poor sailor blames the wind. A poor worker blames the tool.
Who do a poor leader, preacher, or member blame? Who do accountable people blame?

The way that leads to life is hard but not impossible. We've discussed changing our mindset from "I deserve" to "I am responsible". We've looked at being motivated to "press on". Finally, I want us to examine the statement "I am accountable".
I want us to work hard to not fall into the way that is "easy" and "entitled". It doesn't lead to any good results.

Our culture is reaping the consequences of entitled living. We need to do our jobs to the best of our abilities. We also need to be accountable to ourselves and to God with the jobs we are doing. In other words, maybe the problem is not with "them". Maybe the problem is failure to hold ourselves accountable. *"For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad."* (2 Corinthians 5:10). Let me end with this accountable approach to prayer. "God, grant me the serenity to accept the people I cannot change, the courage to change the ones I can, and the wisdom to know that one person is me."

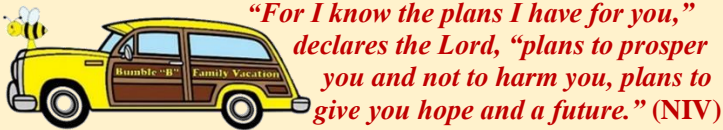
