Philemon 9-14 (NKJV)

9 Yet for love’s sake I rather appeal to you—being such a one as Paul, the aged, and now also a prisoner of Jesus Christ— 10 I appeal to you for my son Onesimus, whom I have begotten while in my chains, 11 who once was unprofitable to you, but now is profitable to you and to me. 12 I am sending him back. You therefore receive him, that is, my own heart, 13 whom I wished to keep with me, that on your behalf he might minister to me in my chains for the gospel. 14 But without your consent I wanted to do nothing, that your good deed might not be by compulsion, as it were, but voluntary.

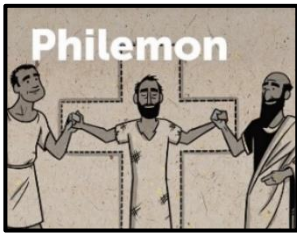

Philemon: The Bond That Holds Us – “Onesimus’ Predicament”

What keeps you from running away from your responsibilities? What holds you to your commitment to your family, friends, work, and the church? Have you been tempted to just “run away”? I was a child when I got the idea to run away from home. I acted on that and walked outside and into the backyard. I have no idea why I thought about this.

It could have been that I wanted bologna when my mother gave me peanut butter for lunch. I walked to the edge of our property and quickly realized that this was not a good idea. I ran back home. My love for my family brought me back.

Onesimus was a runaway slave who found Paul and the Lord. His master, Philemon, was a Christian believer as well. What would Paul do? Did he keep Onesimus with him? Did he send him back to Philemon? Paul sent Onesimus back with this powerful letter. Onesimus needed to return home. This was the only way to ensure complete reconciliation. Paul wanted Onesimus and Philemon to know that a stronger bond holds us all. *“Yet for love’s sake I rather appeal to you - being such a one as Paul, the aged, and now also a prisoner of Jesus Christ.”* (Philemon 9)



What keeps us from running away from family and the faith is our loving connection to God. If you are tempted to leave your commitments, maybe this small letter is what you need. We all need to remember the “bond that holds us”.
