Thank you so much for the hugely generous diaper drop for our Hallie. These will be so useful over the coming months, & we are enormously appreciative of your kindness & generosity.

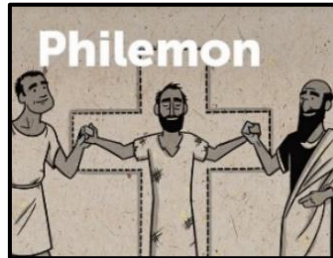
It is hard to believe that Hallie is almost a month old! We are so thankful for your continued love & prayers & are excited for Hallie to meet all her church friends soon!

Philemon: The Bond That Holds Us – “Paul’s Plea”

I’m so impressed with Paul’s writing to Philemon. He wisely wrote the right things and left out the wrong things. I mean, he didn’t say, “You are a Christian! Why do you have slaves?” He didn’t say, “Onesimus is no longer a problem, and you don’t make it one!” I remember telling our boys when they were younger, “Because I said so!” Sometimes I wish it was that easy with adults. “You need to follow Jesus.” “Why?” “Because I said so.” What we say to a child is not the same to an adult. We must use tact when speaking the truth in love. Paul had a delicate message to deliver. He had to consider Roman law, culture, and practice. He had to use words only because he was confined to prison. Paul addressed the problem with Onesimus and Philemon with love and grace.

Which is a better response: “You need to do what I tell you and forgive your Christian brother or sister” or “You need to consider forgiveness for Christ’s sake because we all need God’s forgiveness”? Paul’s plea is an example to us all.



Do we speak more than the truth? Do we speak it in love? Do we consider “in Christ” when we address one another? What do you say? We need to work out disagreements and disappointments for “Christ’s sake”. It’s not about just you. We are connected by the greatest bond that holds us.
