Philemon: The Bond That Holds Us – “God’s Purpose”

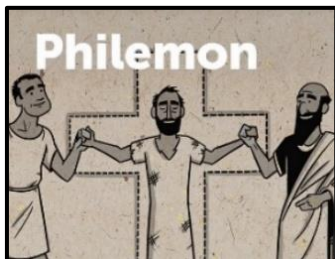
We have considered Onesimus’ Predicament as a runaway slave in the first century. We looked at Philemon’s Problem with him accepting or rejecting his new brother in Christ. We studied Paul’s Plea with Philemon for love’s sake of Onesimus.

What about God? What did He think about all of this?

I believe God’s Purpose is found in Paul’s statement about a greater purpose. *“For perhaps he departed for a while for this purpose, that you might receive him forever.”* (Philemon 15) Was it luck that Onesimus escaped Philemon and found Paul? Is life about luck, chance, and wishful hope? Paul saw a greater purpose in the situation. Perhaps Philemon’s financial setback was for the purpose of Onesimus’ salvation. Perhaps Paul’s chains were for the purpose of reaching and converting Onesimus. God’s Purpose is much greater than our perceived problems. Is it possible that what we perceive as being bad is actually for the greater good?

I cannot speak for you, but I can for me. My health issues from a brain tumor weren’t because of God. However, God has taken this perceived bad situation and worked it for the good. I can relate to patients lying in a hospital bed not knowing what will happen next. I can understand someone’s constant pain throughout their life. My eyes are open wider and fuller because of this. Perhaps I endure this health challenge because it will reach others to Christ. I embrace that fully if that is the case. God’s purpose is greater than our perceived problems. He continues to work together for the good. Perhaps the season you are in is for the reason to reach someone to Christ. Perhaps...
