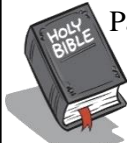

Hope In A Hopeless World: Hope Amid Sickness

I've admired Joey Spann over the years. He is known in West Nashville for his service in ministry, education, and coaching. He has spoken at Charlotte Heights about his earthly trials. He almost died while coaching with a massive heart attack.

He was wounded in a church attack. His family struggles with sickness. I've visited Coach Spann in his classroom to check on him. He doesn't show or let on that the weight of the world is on his shoulders. His wife passed away recently, and he still displayed strength in the service for Peggy Spann. He has demonstrated faith amid sickness. I believe he is a modern-day "Job-like" Christian.

Joey is one of many present-day and former examples of people holding on to hope amid sickness. The Bible is filled with people who suffered from various diseases but maintained their hope in God. Paul's "thorn in the flesh" brought him closer to God. Job sat in an ash heap, covered with boils while not cursing God. The woman with an issue of blood had the faith to reach out and touch Jesus.

In this hopeless, fallen, and sick world, we need the hope of God to sustain us through this temporary life. We need to know, in the midst of sickness, that God hasn't left us.

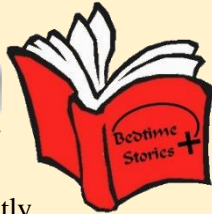
