About Our Speaker – Noel Stafford

Noel and Jessica Stafford plan to move to Moshi, Tanzania, sometime in early 2022. Both Noel & Jessica are Freed-Hardeman graduates. Noel graduated with a Bachelor's Degree in Bible with an emphasis on Missions.

Noel is currently working on a chicken farm with his father-in-law and brother-in-law. They are currently living in Clifton, TN. They have four children: Lorelai (15), Claude (13), Arabella (12), and Juliette (9).

Noel and Jessica actually met in 2002 on a mission trip to Tanzania and, exactly one year later, were married.

Both Noel and Jessica grew up in the mission field as teenagers. Noel lived in Chimala, Tanzania from 1991 to 1994. Then, in 1998, his father, Cy Stafford, started a new work in Northern Tanzania in the cities of Arusha and Moshi. The goal was to evangelize, train preachers, plant churches, have leadership (elders and deacons) in the churches, and have the churches be self-reliant. This work has flourished in those years, and many of these goals have been reached.

Then in February of 2017, Cy Stafford passed away. The work continues, and things are getting back to normal.

With the passing of his father, Noel went back to Tanzania later that year to help his mother get things in order. This trip opened his eyes and reminded him of where he was meant to be. In early 2020, the Lord opened up a door that they thought was closed. Noel and Jessica decided it was time for them to help continue what was started by his father. After spending 3 weeks in Arusha and Moshi later in 2020, they realized that the biggest need for them would be in Moshi, while still helping where needed in Arusha.



Noel will be bringing us our sermon this morning. He will also be presenting the mission work in Tanzania during Sunday School.

All Adult Classes will stay in the auditorium for his presentation.
