Enough Is Greater Gain: Less Than Enough

Less Than Enough? If enough means clothing, shelter, and daily bread, what does it mean to have less than enough? I know I'm blessed with a tremendous upbringing and support system with my family. I've never been in a situation that was less than enough. There were times when money was really tight because Janet wanted to be a stay-at-home mom. We went from two incomes down to one. We made it just fine without sacrificing greatly.

I have been in places temporarily where I was surrounded by those with less than enough. I've seen less than enough in our backyard. Millions of people are forced to make hard choices because of making less than enough. They have to choose between paying the utilities or buying groceries. There are those who cannot afford a Christmas present for their family. There are those who go to bed not knowing where their next meal is coming from. Jesus said, "For you have the poor with you always, and whenever you wish you may do them good." (Mark 14:7) We can easily dismiss those who have less than enough. We can say things like "All they need is Jesus" or "I can't solve their problems" or "If I start helping, I might make them more dependent on me."

The book of James answers all these excuses about not helping a brother or sister in need. Faith without works is dead.

We help several with "less than enough" as a church. I'm thankful we do. What about us, individually? When we have an opportunity, do we help those with "less than enough"? Are we so focused on gaining more stuff that we neglect or overlook the ones who need help? We are to be doers and not problem solvers. We cannot solve the world's problems of poverty, addiction, and low-income. We can care enough to help.
