Until He Comes: "Let Out" - Fellowship In The Gospel

Are we mindful of Who is coming soon? We may get so distracted by the temporary things in this life that we forget. Jesus is coming, and He is coming soon. What are we to do in the meantime? The book of Philippians offers some things for us to do while we wait for the Lord. I cannot think of a better start to this New Year than a loving and positive letter from Paul. We need to hear and be reminded that our gracious Lord will come at any time. We need to be watchful and ready.

I want you to think of Philippians in four statements. They are *Let Out*, *Let In*, *Let Go*, and *Let Known*.

Philippians is one of Paul's prison epistles. His physical predicament didn't keep him from writing his rejoicing letter. Paul reminds us of the main things in life. What we have in common as a church is more than a fellowship meal, more than an exciting activity, and more rewarding than any other fellowship. What we have in common is Christ. Paul started his letter by referring to himself and Timothy as bondservants of Jesus Christ. He wrote to a church in Christ Jesus. Christ is not just the beginning and the end. He is in the in-between in this life. What we have in common with our brothers and sisters is Christ. Our fellowship is worthy of us to *Let Out* a life that glorifies God. This New Year must include our faith growing in the Lord.

You may participate in the following ways.

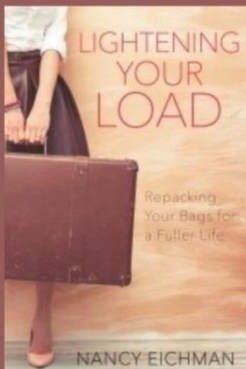
1. Pick up materials to send a note of encouragement to our Sick & Shut-Ins.
