How many souls were added to the Kingdom because of a need met by a disaster?

How many churches were strengthened during a natural disaster?

How many unfaithful souls are rededicated due to the love and support of God's people nationally? **Churches of Christ Disaster Relief Effort** began unofficially in 1990. Since then, the non-profit has distributed more than \$168 million in emergency food and supplies to over 535 disasters in 47 states, Puerto Rico, and the U.S. Virgin Islands.

We are told in the book of Acts of a great famine that spread throughout the world. This natural disaster took place during the rule of Claudius Caesar. How did the early church endure this difficult situation? *"Then the disciples, each according to his ability, determined to send relief to the brethren dwelling in Judea."* (Acts 11:29)

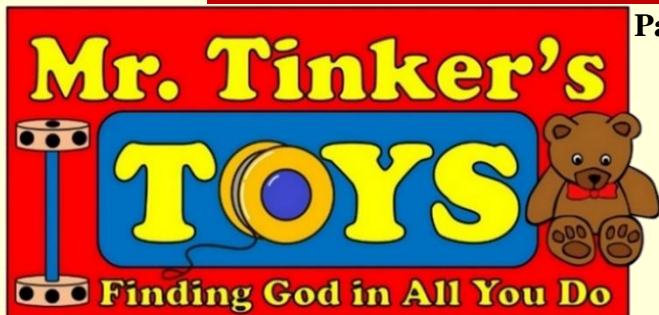
