His name was Andrew, and he was named after the Apostle Andrew. Josh and April work with the Lord’s church in Pikeville, Kentucky. He used to minister for the church in Morristown, TN. We need to be thankful in everything, for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you. This requires us to practice thanksgiving in bad, sad, and difficult times. How? Consider God’s word to help us practice thanksgiving. What we show to others in difficult times may be what that person needs to let go of and give to God.

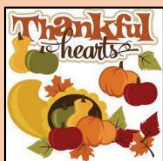
