Blessed Beginnings - Makarios

The Greek word “*Makarios*” is a powerful and rich term that has been translated as “*Blessed*” in English. It appears over 60 times in the New Testament, and it is used to describe a person who is fortunate or happy in a spiritual or eternal sense. The term is often associated with blessings that come from God and are not connected to temporal or worldly wealth or success. In the Beatitudes in Matthew 5, Jesus uses the word “*Makarios*” to describe those who are poor in spirit, those who mourn, the meek, those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, the merciful, the pure in heart, the peacemakers, and those who are persecuted for righteousness. He says that these individuals are blessed because they will receive the blessings of eternal life in heaven.

Additionally, “*Makarios*” appears in the Lord’s Prayer, where Jesus teaches His disciples to pray for God’s blessings and protection. In this context, the word conveys a sense of spiritual well-being, contentment, and happiness that comes from being in a right relationship with God. The word “*Makarios*” can also be translated as “*Happy*” or “*Fortunate*” in certain contexts, and it is often used to describe people who are experiencing joy and peace in the midst of difficult circumstances. This highlights the idea that true happiness and blessings come not from outward circumstances but from our connection to God.
