He Understands - Introduction To The Series

Do you sometimes feel removed from God because of the flesh? A member reached out to me this past week feeling stuck with sharing the gospel with a friend. Their friend responded to the gospel by, "I'm too far gone." I reminded the member that "too far gone is six feet in the ground". Many people feel they cannot relate to God or His church. They don't believe anyone understands them. This is so far from the truth.

We serve a Lord and Savior who understands us. He understands disappointments. He understands setbacks. He understands pain and suffering. He understands unfair events. "For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin." (Hebrews 4:15) We serve a Savior who knows our weaknesses. How? He was not removed from temptation and experiences while in the flesh. Jesus came to earth and lived as we do, and He experienced physical life. What Jesus experienced on the cross and what He said reveals to us that He understands.

I want us to spend time examining the words Jesus said before His death. We start with one of the hardest things - Forgiveness. Jesus preached on forgiveness in His Sermon on the Mount. He demonstrated forgiveness while on the cross. If you struggle to forgive or you believe you will never forgive, Jesus understands.



He understands the struggle to forgive when someone doesn't ask for it. What Jesus did and said is not so far removed from our own lives. We need to draw closer because He knows our weaknesses.
