Two women are responsible for our national day to recognize fathers. Grace Clayton was a daughter of a minister and proposed a day to honor fathers after the worst mining accident in West Virginia. Another woman, Sonora Dodd, was raised by her father. While attending a Mother's Day service, Sonora proposed a day to honor fathers. She wanted the day to be the 5th day in June. However, the committee chose the 3rd Sunday in June because it wasn't so close to Mother's Day. It would take time for Congress to catch up and make the day a national holiday.

The third hymn is one I haven't sung or heard of. The hymn is a personal prayer written down and submitted for publication. Anne Steele became a coworker for her father. Her mother died when she was three years old. Anne had a lot of setbacks in her life. She worked with her father as he ministered for a church in England. 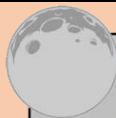
