### Genesis 37:3-8 (NKJV)

3 Now Israel loved Joseph more than all his children, because he was the son of his old age. Also he made him a tunic of many colors. 4 But when his brothers saw that their father loved him more than all his brothers, they hated him and could not speak peaceably to him. 5 Now Joseph had a dream, and he told it to his brothers; and they hated him even more. 6 So he said to them, "Please hear this dream which I have dreamed: 7 There we were, binding sheaves in the field. ## A Colorful Life: Introduction to the Series

I thought all families were like mine when I was younger. I thought that until I stayed the night at a good friend's house. I noticed their house smelled different than mine. I also observed that their house rules were not the same as mine. As I got older, I saw some homes with only one parent and other homes with mixed family members because of divorce and remarriage. These differences and changes leave a lasting impact on our homes, churches, and community.

The Book of Genesis shows us inside Jacob's house. Jacob was married to Rachel and Leah. This brought about jealousy and struggles. Jacob loved Rachel, but she was unable to have children. Leah had children, but she wanted Jacob's love. The birth of Jacob's sons transferred problems from one generation to another. Jacob was a passive husband and provided little leadership to resolve the jealousy between the two sisters. Sons were born from Leah, Rachel, and their maidservants. Jacob's home gives a new meaning to a dysfunctional family. From what we read in Genesis, the multi-generational family was headed to a hopeless end. Then, God opened Rachel's womb, and she conceived and bore a son. She called his name "Joseph", meaning "The Lord shall add to me another son" (Genesis 30:24).

The past can be changed. The downward cycle can be broken if there is a willingness to forgive and change. God would redeem this family through the acts of Joseph. If God can redeem this family, there is hope for every other family.
