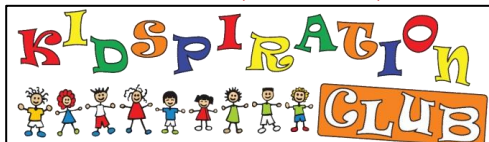

A Colorful Life: Helper

Joseph had provided a meal for his brothers. They drank and were merry with the Egyptian official (Genesis 43:34). Who was merry? The brothers were delighted. What about Joseph? It doesn't say he was bright with them. Why would he be merry? They had buried their sin and allowed time to pass without confession.

Their sacks were full of grain, and their brother Simeon was back with them. The ruler had sent them on their way back to Canaan. It was indeed a happy day on the surface. They didn't possess authentic joy because they were not free from guilt and sins. We are to bear one another's burdens to fulfill the law of Christ (Galatians 6:2). These burdens are not just experiencing a person's bad day or facing their health challenges. They are the burdens of sin.

Joseph created a test to put his brothers in a position to see what they had done. You cannot treat someone as they treated Joseph and assume everything is alright with God. Their grain sacks and Simeon's return didn't mean that God was pleased with them. They needed the right moment to address their consciences. They needed someone to help them to focus upward and not outward. We can learn from Joseph to be available and willing to help people with sin. Sometimes, people don't go to God first but to us. We can help carry their burdens by leading them back to God. It is far better to receive help than never to be helped at all.
